The agenda was to understand NDIS investment and the Australian property market. The distinguished speakers were **Cameron Anderson** and **Heath Anderson**,

who discussed exploring the potential for strong returns in NDIS Investment properties.

Key Takeaways:

- Cameron's thorough coverage provided new and existing members valuable insights into NDIS investment and the Australian property market.
- From the general state of the property market to the intricate details
 of NDIS offerings, the speaker's content and Q&A sessions gave
 attendees a solid understanding.
- Cameron's use of examples simplified complex concepts, making them accessible to all attendees.
- The session sparked interest among the audience, prompting them to consider engaging with Silverhall for potential investments.

KPMG on Emerging Risk



On April 16, 2024, a Continuing Professional Development (CPD) event on Emerging Risks was held at CPA Australia. Lady Pastidio and Andriana Marques from KPMG led the event. During the event, the attendees were given valuable insights on various topics, such as global and sector-specific risks, the evolving role of chartered accountants in risk management, and effective government strategies.

Key Takeaways:

- The session highlighted how cybersecurity concerns have transitioned from data security to include staff awareness and phishing training, while technology and transformation topics now emphasise managing change and upskilling staff rather than just process improvement.
- Looking ahead to 2024, CAs must prepare for emerging risks such as financial regulatory changes, ASIC's intensified scrutiny on greenwashing, and the growing importance of climate-related financial disclosures and reporting standards.

India Advantage Roadmap Ahead



On April 30, 2024, a Continuing Professional Development (CPD) event on India Advantage Roadmap Ahead was held at CAANZ. The event was led by Dr. S Janakiraman as the Chief Guest, along with CA Aniket Talati and Ram Gorlamandala as speakers.

Key Topics Discussed:

- India's Growth: India, the 5th largest economy, is driving initiatives like "Make in India" and "Atmanirbhar Bharat" (self-reliance), with production-linked incentives attracting substantial investments (Rs 1000 crores in PLI schemes).
- International Recognition: ICAI, with its vast network of members
 and students, recently co-hosted a historic international accounting
 conference after 118 years. This achievement not only showcases the
 global reach of Indian professionals but also fills us with pride. IndiaAustralia
- Collaboration: Trade is shifting towards South Asia, with
 opportunities arising for Australian businesses. India's improved ease
 of doing business and focus on infrastructure development create a
 strong foundation for partnerships. Australia's rich mineral resources
 are seen as crucial for India's growth.
- Focus on "Bharat" (India): The government's push addresses the unique needs of the domestic market, like home delivery of milk.
- GIFT City: Gujarat International Finance Tech City (GIFT City) offers a compelling investment opportunity with its IFSC Act, relaxed regulations, and tax benefits.
- Future Collaborations: Discussions explored potential collaborations in pharmaceuticals (API) and building a strong, formal supply chain between India and Australia.




2. CA Divaz


